CHECK-IN INFORMATION:

Groups (players, coaches, spectators) will enter the facility TOGETHER during their scheduled arrival time when the WHOLE party is present. Please wait outside (dress appropriately) until everyone in the group is present. Everyone in the group should use hand sanitizer or wash their hands before entering the concession area. Rostered staff and players will be counted and sent off to their assigned team zone. The team's spectators will be checked in from the team's submitted pass list and allowed into the gym from there.

Spectators should be on the team pass list by 6 p.m. Friday, Feb. 26.

- * Teams that PLAY 7:30am match = arrive between 6:50a-7:10a

- * Teams that PLAY 8:30am match = arrive between 7:45-8:00a

Sunday Arrival Times (PM WAVE - 17s 18s)

- * Teams that PLAY 2:30pm match = arrive between 1:50p-2:10p
- * Teams that REF 2:30pm match = arrive between 2:10p-2:20p
- * Teams that PLAY 3:30pm match = arrive between 2:45p-3:00p

- * Teams arriving between 8:45a-9:00a = MWP 13 Black, Club Breakout 13
- * Teams arriving between 9:00a-9:15a = MWP 13 Red, Sting 13 Black
- * Teams arriving between 10:00a-10:15a = FC Elite 13 Navy, Sting 13 White, Sting 13 Gold

SPECTATOR POLICY - TOURNAMENT RULES - FACILITY GUIDE

REMINDER FOR DIRECTORS AND COACHES:

- * A SPORTS ENGINE roster is required at check-in on your first day of competition. There, directors/coaches will also make confirmation of their bid declaration.
- * New this year: A bid acceptance letter must be signed on site before a bid to the national championships will be delivered to a club. Team photos will be taken on court after the document is signed and the bid certificate is handed off.
- * All trickle down/bid reallocation information is available on the Badger Region website. [CLICK HERE](#).
- * If a pass list is not submitted prior to 24 hours from the start of the event, no spectators will be allowed inside the facility for that team. Link to submit spectator pass list [CLICK HERE](#). (Exceptions for Sunday attendance base on Saturday's performance)
- * Each rostered player and coach will need to fill out a COVID Wavier form for each day. These waiver forms can be completed the day prior to play but MUST be completed before the team check in or they will not be able to participate. ONLY coaches and players fill out this form = [PARTICIPANT COVID WAIVER FORM](#)
- * Chaperones and/or team managers will NOT be issued credentials for this event.
- * Each team will be issued up to 3 credentials for rostered staff. No more than 3.

REMINDER FOR SPECTATORS:

- * Each team is allowed 4 spectators per team per day. \$5 admission each day. (Checks not accepted).
- * Spectators on the pass list will need to purchase admission at check in.
- * Spectators CANNOT rotate through the spectator spots during the day of the event. Once a spectator is checked in, that spectator is locked into the event for that day. Spectators MUST have their wrist band properly secured on their wrist for entry into the gym.
- * Spectators CAN alternate days for a multi-day event IF the coach or director submits a second pass list for the team.
- * All spectators MUST be masked up properly covering the mouth and nose.
- * Spectators have priority over athletes for bleacher seating. Athletes who are off can use the concessions area or stay in their designated team zones.

REMINDER FOR PLAYERS:

- * Please be respectful of the facility.
- * Do not bounce balls off the drywall or purposely bounce / throw volleyballs up in the ceiling where the lights are hanging.

LIVE STREAMING:

- * Live streams for the matches this weekend can be purchased for \$10 per day.

- * Teams setting up their own private live streams, please be aware that there is no extra bandwidth or internet inside the facility to share.

PARKING AT THE MSC:

- * All parking is free. The main north and south lots are available for parking. Please park within the marked parking space.
- * Vehicles that choose to create their own parking spots and hinder or stop the flow of traffic will risk getting their vehicle towed.
- * Please do not visit the shelter area with picnic tables. That belongs to the organization next door

ATHLETIC TRAINER:

- * Froedtert Athletic Training Service will have a trainer on site during the event. If a player is injured and a parent is not in the building, a designated individual will call the player's parent/guardian to inform them of the injury.
- * KT tape is NOT available with the trainer. Athletes should bring their own if needed.
