#### 2021-22 SEASON BEGINS

#### REFEREE REMINDERS

- \* Do teams SWITCH sides at Badger region events? For USAV/Badger Region sanctioned events, teams do not switch sides in a match, unless there is a clear or unfair advantage of being on one side versus another. This is based on individual courts not the tournament as a whole.
- \* Do teams "shake hands before and after match? No. Badger Region is promoting the standard protocol but instead of going all the way to the net, players go to the 10 foot line of each respective side and wave. During the captains meeting "introduce yourself from a distance" is a good approach to say. Only 1 player is required for the Captain meeting but more may attend.
- \* What do I need to know about Zebra Web? Your Zebra Web account needs some love. Don't log in at the beginning of the year and forget about it. Log in weekly, block (or un-block) your schedule as changes happen. The officials' assigner depends on your information being up to date. And, don't forget, please make sure to accept or decline your assignments within 72 hours of receiving them. Thanks in advance.

### Officials receive pay increase at signature events

The Badger Region Board of Directors approved in September an increase in officials pay at the marquee events hosted by the Badger Region.

Those events include the Badger Region Power League, Badger Region Qualifier, Badger Region Championships and Dale Rohde Memorial Boys Tournament.

The pay increase would help the Region ensure high quality officials would attend the event and reward officials who serve at the Region's signature tournaments.

The pay increase puts officials at the following rates:

- \* Provisional: \$30/match
- \* Regional: \$32/match
- \* Junior National: \$34/match
- \* National: \$35/match

These event will also serve as a great opportunity for officials to serve a different role such as scorers, observers and mentors.

Due to the timing and immediate budget impact this change could have on local tournaments, the smaller Badger Region-sanctioned events will not be required at this time to pay the higher rate.

By approving the pay increase, the Badger Region hopes to stay competitive in the officials' market for strong officials who often have options as to where they can officiate on a given weekend during the club volleyball season.

The goal of the Badger Region is to recruit new officials, train officials, mentor officials and retain officials in the state of Wisconsin and throughout the Badger Region.
