Carthage hosting men's national championship

Finals Saturday in Kenosha

Who will it be? Carthage, Springfield, Wentworth or Stevens?

Those are the Final Four teams invited to Carthage College for the NCAA Div. III Men's National Volleyball Championship set for this Friday and Saturday (April 22-23).

The first match of the weekend featuring Springfield and Stevens will kick off at 5 p.m. on Friday. The Carthage vs. Wentworth match will take place at 7:30 p.m. Friday night.

Saturday's national championship match will take place at 5 p.m. in the Tarble Arena located 2001 Alford Park Drive, Kenosha.

General admission is \$10 per day. Children under 12 years old and seniors 65 and older are \$5 per day.

Tickets are available online and will be sold at the door (cash only).

Parking will be available both days of competition in the South Lower Lot outside of Tarble Arena, off of Sheridan Road. For the Final Four and Championship game only, the price to park is \$5 per day (cash only). Cars can enter campus from the south and north end of Campus Drive; while the normal entrance to the South Lower lot to Sheridan will be used as an exit only.

The final regular season NVA/AVCA Men's Div. III poll has Springfield as the No. 1 team in the country, followed by Carthage at No. 2, Stevens at No. 4 and Wentworth at No. 7.

To get to the National Semifinals Car-



thage had to defeat No. 3-ranked Dominican University (River Forest, Ill.), a team the Firebirds lost to in the regular season.

This year, Carthage is 22-3 and won the regular season of the CCIW conference, the conference tournament and the NCAA Regional hosted at Carthage last week.

Zach Bulthuis, Kyle Cohan, David Markes (a Badger Region alum), Gene McNulty and Matt Slivinski were named First Team All-American last week by the AVCA. Carter Schmidt (a Badger Region alum) was named Second Team All-American. Markes was also named the AVCA Newcomer of the Year.

The Firebirds are coached by Badger Region's own JW Kieckhafer, a coach at Milwaukee Volleyball Club and a member of the Badger Region's High Performance program coaching staff.

Free boys volleyball clinic planned prior to title game

The Badger Region will be hosting a free clinic for all boys 14-and-under prior to the NCAA Div. III National Championship on Saturday, April 23, at Carthage College in Kenosha, Wis.

The clinic will begin at 3 p.m. and go until 4:30 p.m. in the Tarble Athletic and Recreation Center (TARC). The NCAA Div. III National Championship will begin at 5 p.m. in the Tarble Arena.

The clinic is FREE and open to any Badger Region or USA Volleyball member.

Region to host first-ever Girls Future Select clinic

The Badger Region High Performance program is looking to the future.

In hopes of building a Girls Future Select team that will compete in the 2023 USA All-Star Championships, the Region is laying the groundwork now.

That starts with hosting a clinic for girls born in 2010 and 2011 from 1 to 3:30 p.m. on Saturday, April 30, at the New Berlin SportsPlex, 2900

S. 163rd St. in New Berlin. Cost is \$75.

The clinic will be led by current Badger Region High Performance coaches and who will demonstrate techniques and coaching styles that will be used when a team is formed in the 2023 season.

“This model of starting with a clinic the year before we build a team is identical to how we started offering our Boys Future

Select team about four years ago,” said High Performance program director Brian Sharkey. “As long as we see that we have strong interest and good talent at the Future Select level, we’ll be able to make a lot of decisions on how we will operate our program next year.”

Athletes born in 2010, who are technically in the Future Select age group, are still eligible to be a part of our National Select team that

tries out on Friday, March 25, at the Wisconsin Center in downtown Milwaukee. Athletes can try out for the National Select team and still participate in the Future Select clinic.

Scholarship application open to seniors

The Badger Region will again be offering graduating seniors the opportunity to apply for scholarships available to both boys and girls.

This year, the Region will select five boys and 10 girls who meet the criteria for \$500 scholarships that will be paid directly to the student's college of choice once they are enrolled.

In addition, two athletes, one boy and one girl will also be considered for the Frisco Mo "Do Good" scholarship, if they meet the additional criteria required for these \$500 scholarships.

Rewarding service

Lisa Deppe, the founder and owner of Frisco Mo, said her company is all "about rewarding athletes who do good in their community over the past school year."

The first is required by all applicants. The last section is for athletes who want to be considered for the "Frisco Mo Do Good" scholarship, which requires some sort of community service activity



be described in the application. The other Badger Region scholarships do not require community service as part of the criteria.

Criteria

Athletes must meet the following criteria for both scholarships:

- * Graduating high school senior in the year of application (students who graduate in winter will be eligible alongside students who graduate in the spring or summer)
- * No code of conduct violations
- * Student athlete (or coach or official) is member of the Badger Region and is in good standing with the Badger Region Volleyball Association and his or her club
- * Submit a completed application form
- * Submit an acceptance letter from a college, university or other post-secondary academic institution. (To receive payment, proof of registration and enrollment in a post-secondary school will be required)
- * Submit a letter of recommendation from club director or 18s club coach

The deadline to apply is April 29, 2022. Winners will be announced in May.

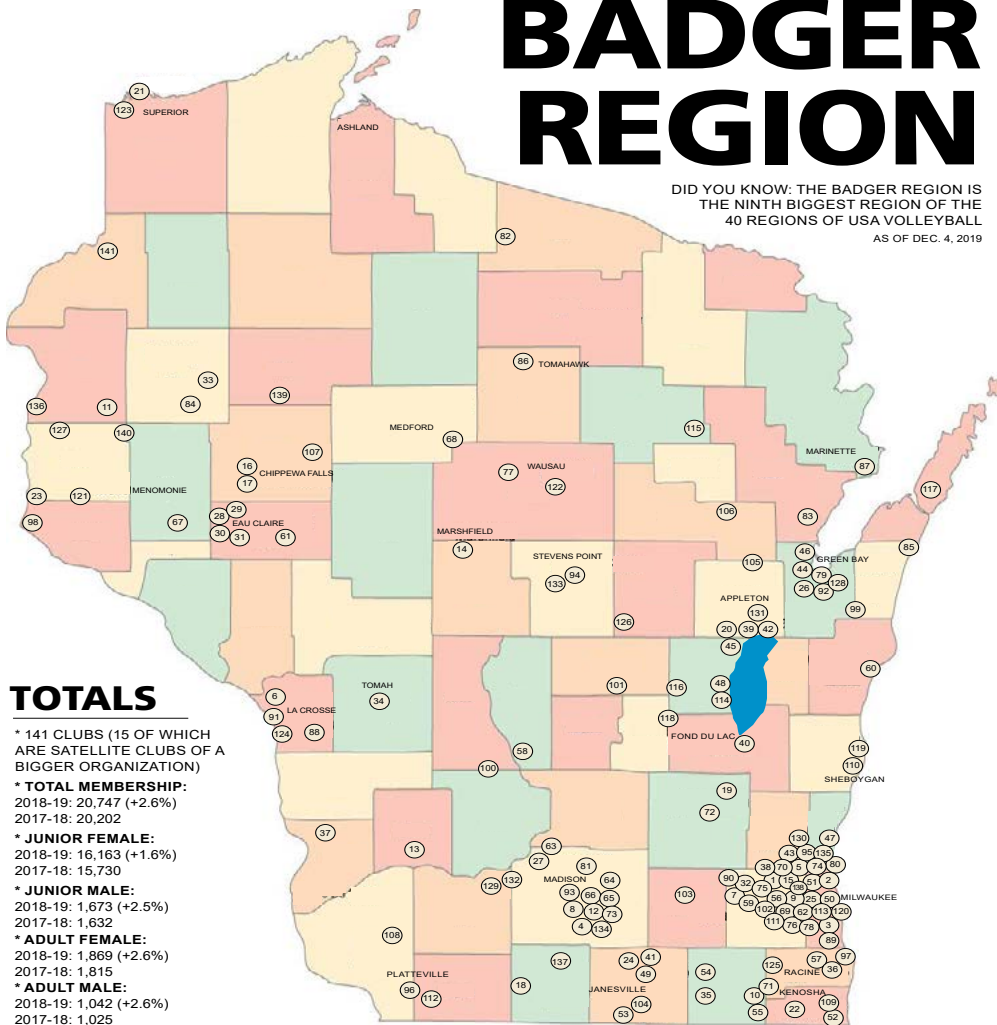

Reminder: All numbers must clearly contrast with the color of the jersey, regardless of the color of the outline of the number.

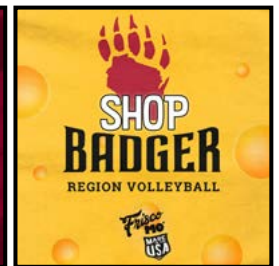

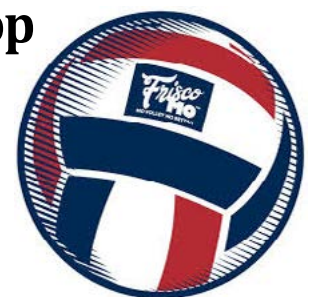
Badger Region, Frisco Mo partner for unique Wisconsin-themed volleyball shop

How is the Badger Region Board structured?

The Badger Region Volleyball Association is governed by a Board of Directors that must be elected by members on a regular basis. Area reps serve three-year terms, while members of the executive board serve four-year terms.

Members, whether they are players, coaches, parents, directors, athletic trainers or officials, are encouraged to communicate with their respective representative if they

think policies or financial decision in the Region need to be changed.

Some policies enforced by Badger Region come from USA Volleyball, our sport's national governing body, so those can't be changed. But many others can.

The Board is advised by a 11 chairpersons (or experts) in various parts of the game, and five staff members (some of which have multiple responsibilities).
