




Coaches come out for Art of Coaching clinic at Marquette

Badger Region athletes chosen for NTDP training

Close to 100 junior girls athletes and 90 junior boys athletes are scheduled to participate in the USA Volleyball National Team Development Program's (NTDP) Spring Training Series events near Chicago.

This training series will give junior athletes the chance to practice with and play against some of the best athletes in the United States while receiving guidance from top coaches.

Girls Under-16 through U19 and boys U17-U20 age groups will run May 6-8 at the Athletico Center in Northbrook, Ill., while girls U15 and boys U16 age groups will run May 7-9 at the Berto Center in Deerfield, Ill.

All training series are conducted by top NTDP coaches throughout the country and features a comprehensive focus on the five pillars of the NTDP: Craft, Mind, Body, Heart and Team.

Athletes for the Spring Training Series were identified and invited based on recommendations from the NTDP Scouting Network. The NTDP Scouting Network serves as the NTDP talent identification process and includes coaches and experts from across the United States.

Boys clinic a hit at Carthage

Prior to winning the Men's NCAA Div. III National Championship, Carthage College head men's volleyball coach JW Kieckhefer stopped by the boys middle school clinic taking place in the Tarble Athletic & Recreation Center.

It was a welcome addition to the clinic hosted by the Badger Region and run by athletes who participate on the Milwaukee Dive semi-professional team — a group that is sponsored by the Badger Region Volleyball

Association.

The clinic was attended by 40 boys all of whom were 14 years of age and younger on Saturday April 23 at Carthage College in Kenosha, two hours before the start of the national championship match between Carthage College and Springfield College.

Each year, the Badger Region partners with as many men's collegiate programs as possible to host free clinics like this in college gyms throughout the state.

Firebirds win second national title

The Carthage College men's volleyball team defeated No. 1 Springfield to win the 2022 Men's Volleyball Division III National Championship on April 23 at Tarble Arena.

The Firebirds' Matt Slivinski, Gene McNulty and Kyle Cohan were named to the all-tournament team while Slivinski was named MVP of the tournament for the second-straight year.

The Firebirds finished the season on a 24-game winning streak.

This is the second team NCAA National Championship for Carthage as they are the first team to repeat since 2018.



Boys Junior Nationals headed to Dallas in '24

Mark your calendars! The 2024 USA Volleyball Boys Junior National Championship (BJNC) will be held deep in the heart of Texas.

Teams will compete June 26-July 3 in Dallas at the Kay Bailey Hutchinson Convention Center.

The BJNC is the United States' premier junior boys club tournament for athletes ages 12-18 and attracts the most elite athletes and college scouts from across the country.

Dallas last hosted the USA Volleyball Boys Junior National Championship in 2019.

"It will be great to return to Dallas for USA Volleyball's 2024 Boys Junior National Championship," said USA Volleyball President and CEO Jamie Davis. "Dallas is such an exciting and diverse city, and we know our athletes and their families and fans will have a great time while competing for one of 17 national titles."

"Dallas has always been known as a hotbed for volleyball," said Dallas Sports Commission Executive Director, Monica Paul. "Hosting the 2024 Boys Junior National Championship is an immense honor as Dallas has a passion for youth sports and we can't wait to welcome one of USA Volleyball's largest events back to our city in 2024."

The 45th edition of the BJNC is expected to bring thousands of athletes, coaches and supporters to Dallas resulting in an economic boost.

Among the current Men's National Team players who have competed at the Boys Junior Nationals are Olympians Matt Anderson, Micah Christenson, T.J. DeFalco, Max Holt and Erik Shoji.

Tulsa to host 2022 Girls Pan American Cup

Eight volleyball teams from North, South and Central America, and the Caribbean will converge on Tulsa, Oklahoma, on July 18-23 for the 2022 U19 Girls Pan American Cup.

The U.S. Girls U19 Team will face the best athletes from across the Americas and the Caribbean to vie for the coveted championship and to qualify for the 2023 FIVB Girls U19 World Championship.

Besides the United States, teams from Brazil, Canada, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, Mexico, Puerto Rico, U.S. Virgin Islands and either Chile or Colombia are expected to compete.



USA Volleyball will host the event in the Grand Hall of the Cox Business Convention Center in conjunction with the USA Volleyball All-Star Championship on July 20-23.

"We are excited to bring this important international competition to Tulsa where the city and competition will be show-cased around the globe," said USA Volleyball President and CEO Jamie Davis. "Fans will have the opportunity to witness some of the best young players in the world play volleyball. Some may have an opportunity to be Olympians in 2024 and 2028."

"Once again, it is an honor to support USA Volleyball especially by hosting the NORCECA eight-team event during All-Star Weekend," said Ashleigh Bachert, Interim Senior Vice President of Tulsa Regional Tourism. "This is a huge opportunity to show skilled players from across

North America and the Caribbean what Tulsa has to offer, and we can't wait to see the Cox Business Convention Center once again receive international attention."



How is the Badger Region Board structured?

The Badger Region Volleyball Association is governed by a Board of Directors that must be elected by members on a regular basis. Area reps serve three-year terms, while members of the executive board serve four-year terms.

Members, whether they are players, coaches, parents, directors, athletic trainers or officials, are encouraged to communicate with their respective representative if they


think policies or financial decision in the Region need to be changed.

Some policies enforced by Badger Region come from USA Volleyball, our sport's national governing body, so those can't be changed. But many others can.

The Board is advised by a 11 chairpersons (or experts) in various parts of the game, and five staff members (some of which have multiple responsibilities).

The state is divided into five parts geographically for representation. Plus, there are two at-large board members who you can approach if you don't feel comfortable with your current rep. And there is a rep dedicated just to issues that surround our Junior volleyball clubs and athletes.

You'll be hearing from each Board member twice a year in the form of a column in the Badger Beacon. Now, let's meet them:
