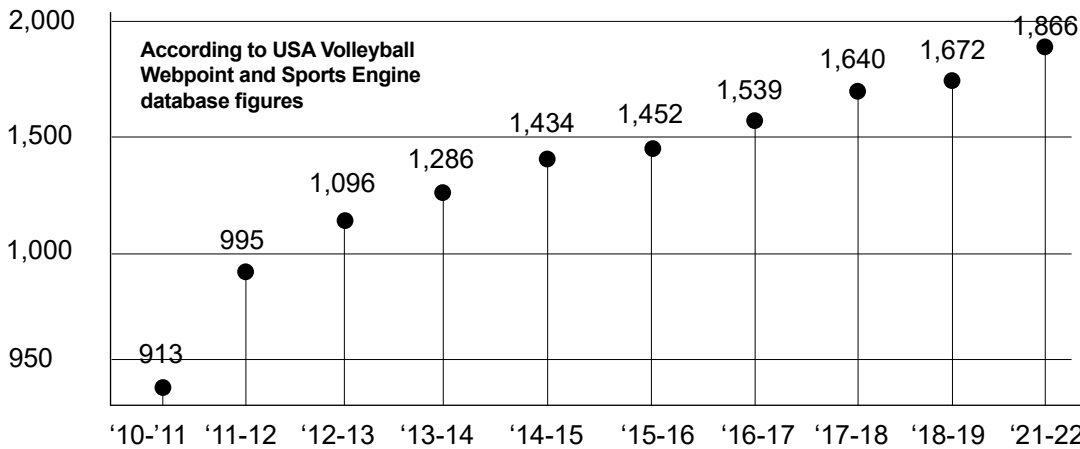

## HIGH SCHOOL BOYS OFFERINGS IN WISCONSIN

In the fall of 2022, there will be 57 teams who will compete in the WIAA State Tournament. There are an additional 10 schools who co-op with those 57 to offer boys volleyball to their male students. There are slated to be a few additional programs not participating in the WIAA Tournament in 2022 also competing in the fall (Port Washington JV, Oconomowoc JV, Waterford JV and Menomonee Falls JV and Varsity -- deemed only a club sport)

This is a 27 percent increase in eight years. Also the number of high schools offer boys volleyball has gone from 2,257 to 2,692 during the same amount of time.
