\* Tryouts most of the time coincide with Badger Region Championships.

\* Lead coaches are required to apply for their positions on the HP staff going to the USA Volleyball Championships

\* Over 300 athletes tried out in 2022. In 2020, the Region started alowing video submissions for tryouts. For the 2022 and 2023 seasons, the age definitions are as follows:

Boys National Youth: Born in 2005 and 2006

Boys National Select: Born in 2007 and 2008 Girls International Youth:

Born in 2006 and 2007 Girls National Select:

Born in 2008 and 2009 The Region is considering sending a Future Select girls team in 2023.



# **BRYFVL/YOUTH CLINICS**

\* The 2021 BRYFVL at the New Berlin Sports Plex and the Milwaukee Sting Center had about 207 teams (both boys and girls) from middle schools around southeast Wisconsin.

\* The Badger Boys Series was home to six 12U teams and eight 13U teams in 2022. This "league" allows boys teams to compete against each other at a reduced rate.

\* The Region ran multiple boys clinics (Carthage/Advanced Skills) and has plans for others in the near future.

# OUTDOOR

\* Badger Region is home to 20 clubs (three of which are beach-only clubs) who outdoor programming.

\* 2022 marked the first year Badger Region coordinated a Beach Calendar with clubs who host events.

\* The Region hosted its first-ever grass tournament attended by 20 teams in 2022 and is looking to do more.

# **POWER LEAGUE/QUALIFIER**

\* 29 clubs sent 170+ plus teams to the three weekends of the Badger Region Power League in 2022. Sites used included the Champions Center in Appleton, Center Court in Waukesha, the OAW Complex in New Berlin, the RecPlex in Pleasant Prairie and UW-Parkside in Kenosha.

\* A record number of teams (101) attended the 2022 Badger Region Qualifier at the Milwaukee Sting Center. With G11s-17s nationals in Indianapolis, lots of Wisconsin teams see this as a close-to-home event.
